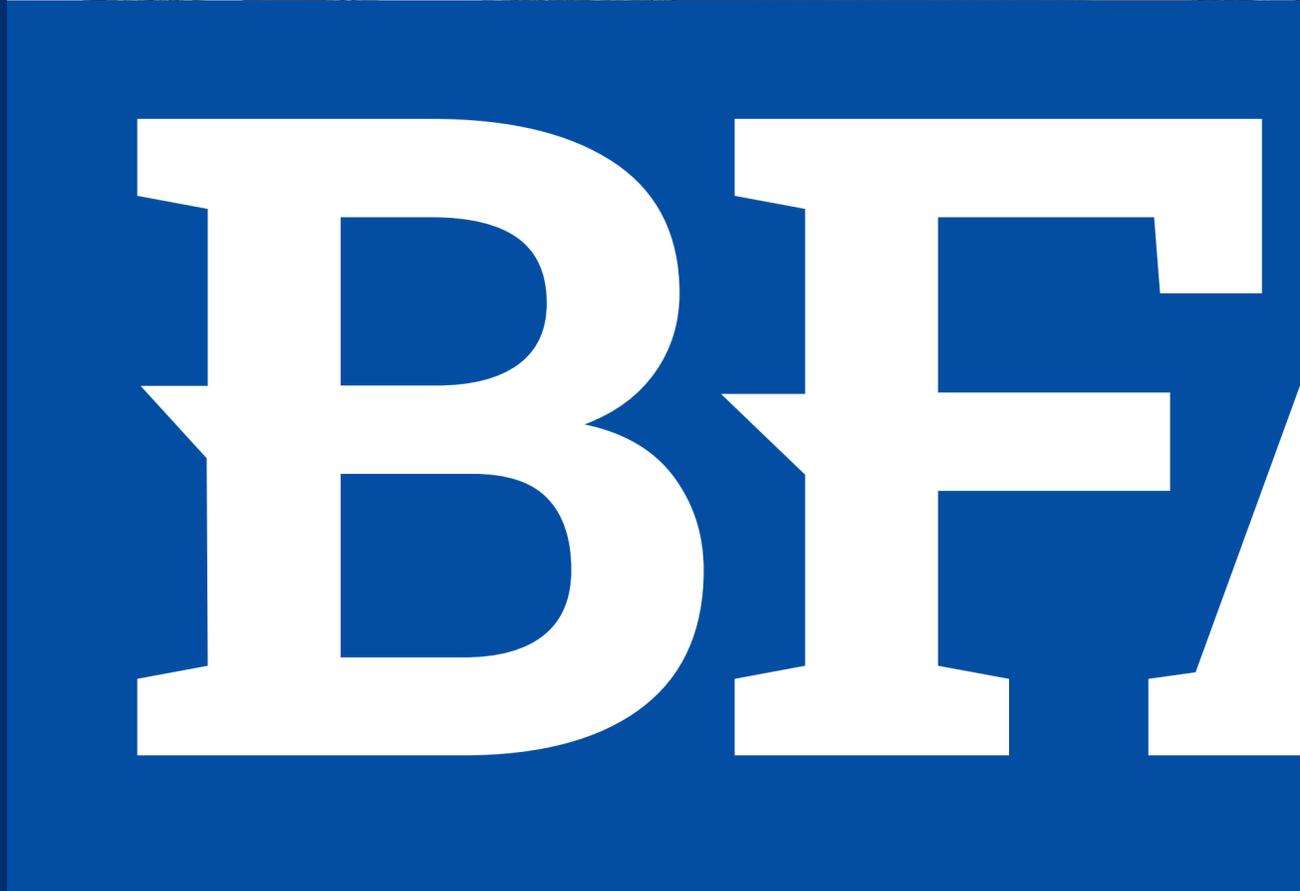

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Black Forest Academy Colors

Which color code should I use?

Different types of color codes are used for different mediums and purposes.

CMYK colors are used for designs that will be printed on paper – use this color code if you are printing on a BFA printer or through an online vendor.

RGB and HEX values are both used to display color on a screen. If your design will be viewed digitally, you should use one of these color codes.

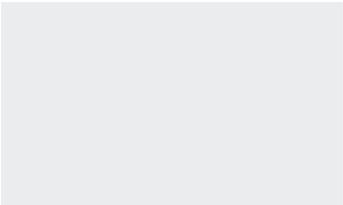

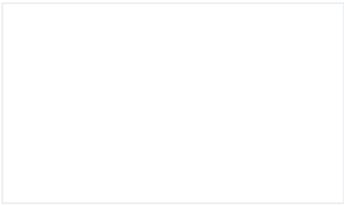

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Secondary Colors

Inspired by the colors of the roof tiles of the church steeple in the center of Kandern, we chose several colors to compliment our primary colors. By integrating these colors into our current palette, we are providing a spark that supports the BFA stories we tell and reminds us of the town we call home.

A general rule for using these colors is to follow the 60/30/10 rule. With 60% of your design a primary color, 30% a primary color, and 10% a secondary color. This ensures the primary color palette is not diluted or lost in any way.

Typefaces & Fonts

BFA uses three typefaces consistently. Lato and Montserrat are our two sans-serif typefaces and our serif typeface is aptly called Young Serif.

Lato is our primary typeface used for headings, subheadings in all applications (web, print, etc.). It is often used in all caps.

LOGOS

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Official BFA Seal

The BFA Seal is our primary logo and draws on our history and core values. With an open Bible as its base, the school's purpose and commitment to serving God's global ministry is central.

It serves as a mark of authenticity and should be used in all formal or institutional contexts—such as certificates, official documents, signage, and high-level communications. The seal must always appear in its approved form, colors, and proportions, with adequate clear space and no alterations or effects.

It should never be distorted, or modified, or altered in any way. Consistent use of the seal reinforces BFA's heritage, credibility, and mission.

Stacked Lockup

A lockup is the combination of a logo and a wordmark, this provides a professional yet familiar design.

The stacked lockup is the primary version of the BFA lockup, arranged in a vertical layout to create a balanced, central design. It features the shield logo and wordmark, maintaining the school's name and location in a clear, unified structure.

This version is best suited for most applications, including print materials, stationery, and formats where a compact, centered presentation is preferred. It reinforces the school's identity while preserving clarity and visual hierarchy across various uses.

Horizontal Lockup

The horizontal lockup is designed to fit spaces where a linear logo is required or preferred. It maintains the shield and uses the horizontal wordmark, keeping the school name and location visible, while offering a more streamlined, balanced appearance.

The alternate lockup provides flexibility in layouts such as website headers, banners, and signage where a horizontal format works best.

Institutional Lockup

The institutional lockup combines the BFA seal with the horizontal lockup, representing both the institution and the school together.

The institutional lockup is to be used in special contexts where formal recognition of BFA's authority and identity is required alongside clear visibility of the school name—such as in school profiles, college applications, or other official contexts.

This lockup balances tradition and approachability, ensuring both the seal's academic authority and the lockup's clarity are preserved in a single, cohesive mark.

Horizontal Wordmark

Wordmarks

A wordmark is a logo comprised of unique, stylized text, usually an organizations name, with no additional icons or symbols. The BFA wordmarks can be used in almost all contexts.

The stacked wordmark is the primary version of Black Forest Academy, designed for standard use where a central, vertical arrangement works best. It emphasizes the school's name clearly and is a strong presence in print, digital, and signage applications.

The alternate wordmark is the horizontal version, created for linear or wide layouts where the stacked wordmark may feel too tall. It provides flexibility while keeping the school name prominent and legible, making it ideal for banners, headers, and other horizontal spaces.

Both wordmarks reinforce BFA's identity with clarity and consistency across all communications.

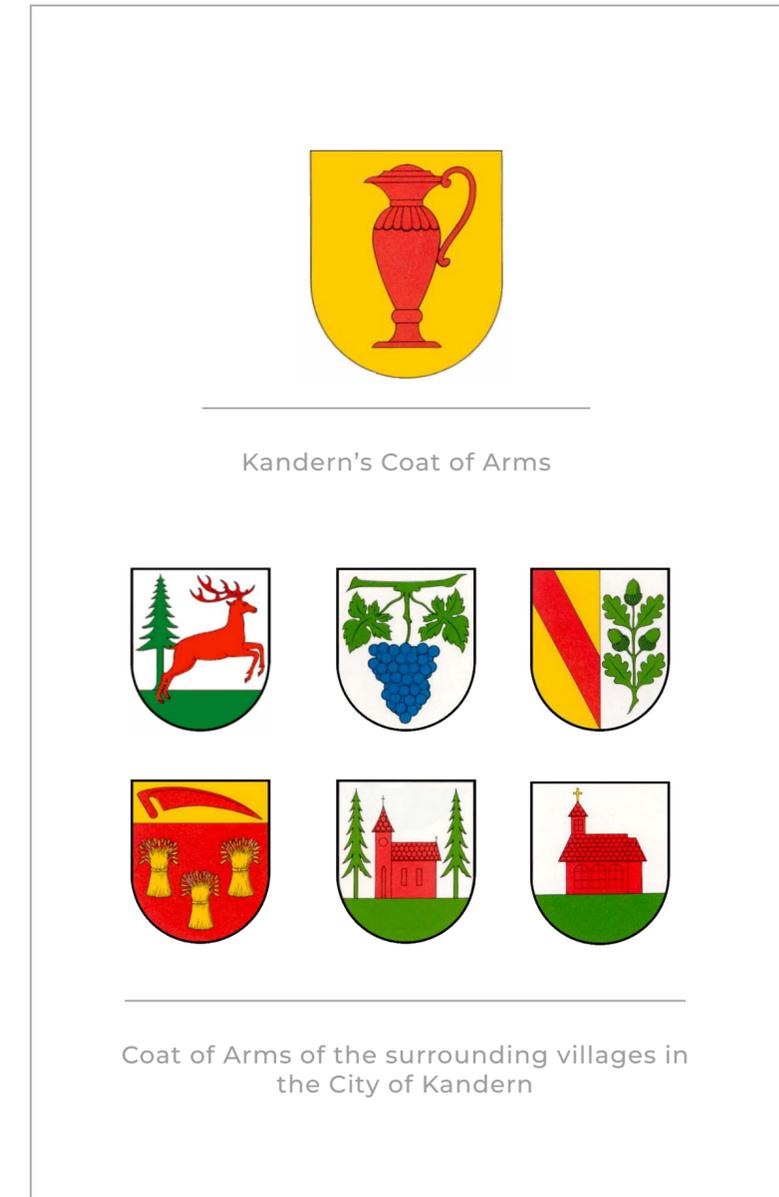
BFA Shield

Inspired by our German heritage in the Black Forest, and the communities around us, the shield symbolizes our roots, mission, and values. The trees and Bible present a picture of a forest along a stream, with BFA situated in the middle. This image is not only geographically accurate, but also calls to mind the imagery found in Psalm 1 and Jeremiah 17.

The BFA Shield should be used independently only in contexts where it is clear that the environment is explicitly associated with Black Forest Academy. When used alone, it reinforces the school's identity and adds visual recognition, but it must never appear in isolation in ambiguous contexts, to prevent confusion or misrepresentation.

Applications

Consistent application ensures that the BFA logo remains clear, legible, and visually unified across all uses, and ensures our colors are used properly. The logo should always be applied on backgrounds that provide sufficient contrast for both the shield and wordmark to remain distinct.

Approved color combinations include the primary BFA palette as well as neutral backgrounds that support clarity and accessibility. The logo may appear in full color, black, or white, depending on the background tone. Clear space must be maintained around all sides of the logo to preserve visibility and impact—no other graphic elements, text, or images should encroach on this area. When placing the logo on color fields, photography, or textured backgrounds, ensure the logo stands out with strong contrast and remains the primary visual focus.

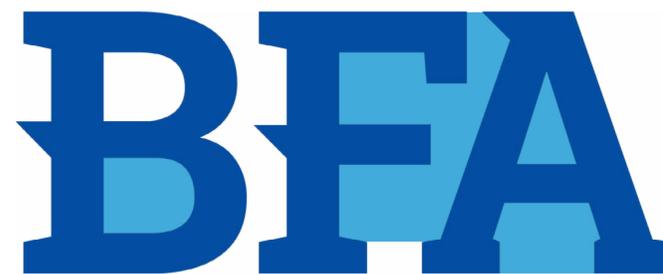

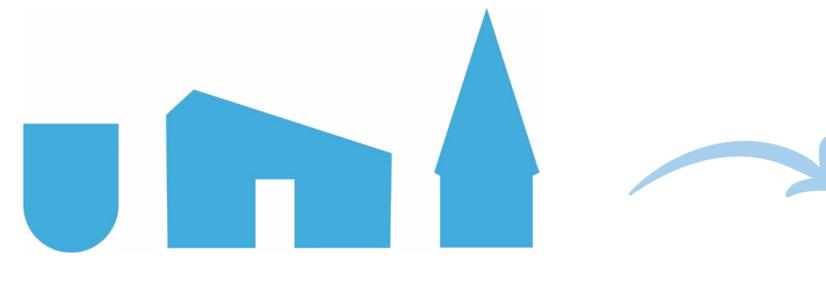
Mission Mark
